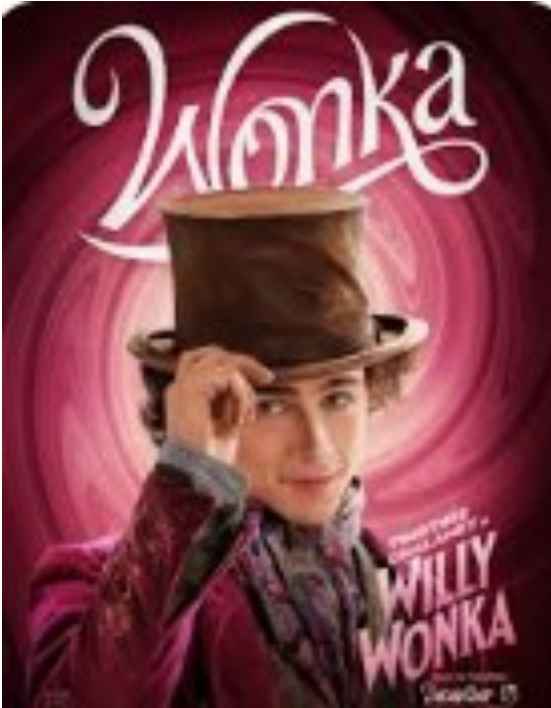
Rewind to Easter
