The school council have enjoyed working with our local Usborne partner to organise a special event for next week - 'Ready, Steady, Read'. Please see the attached poster for details.

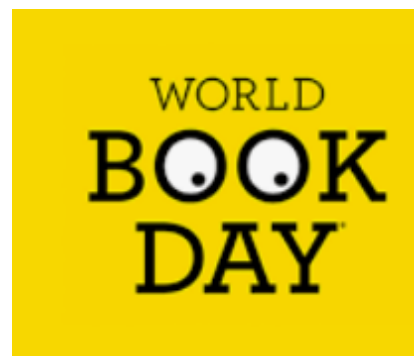
