knowledge to use coding and the associated vocabulary to build games, using detailed algorithms.

Physical Education (P.E.)

As a school, we value physical education through every year group. In key stage 2, we use the specialist services of Kanga Sports to deliver our sessions using the excellent facilities at Upper Wharfedale secondary school.

We are one of the only schools in Craven that provide every year group in key stage 2 with weekly swimming lessons, ensuring our children leave as strong, confident swimmers.

In key stage one, our curriculum was designed to represent the needs of our school using the support of the professional knowledge of Kanga Sports founder to ensure that our curriculum not only meets the expectations of the curriculum but is ambitious for our children.

We support our curriculum with a range of afterschool clubs, extra-curricular activities and as many sporting competitions and experiences as possible.
