Our Christmas Fayre was a huge success, so thank you everyone who attended and a huge THANK YOU to all those parents who helped by running a stall.

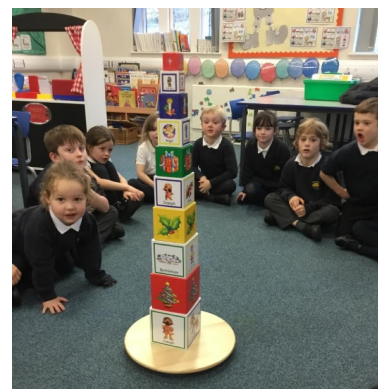
We had Christmas stalls, a café, a children's activity room and Father Christmas even visited us!
