We are taking part in the Mathematics World Cup, against schools from all over the world.

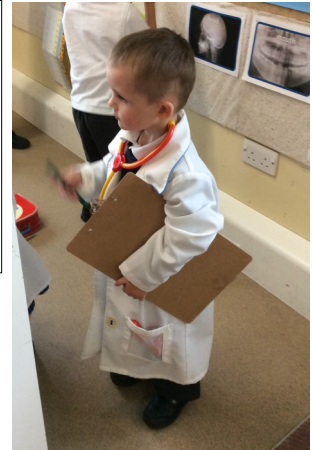
