I have observed some fantastic teamwork during outdoor construction.

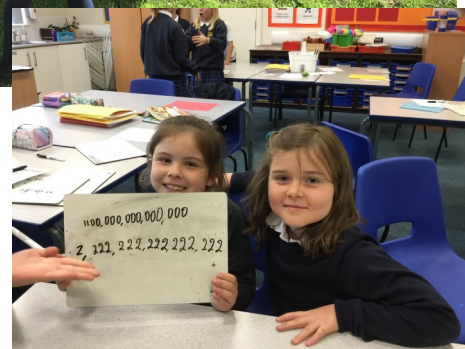
Curlews
