Mr Elliott has had lots of proud teacher moments, seeing just how much progress all the children have made this term.


The poems that children created about a special person were beautifully composed with some really lovely ideas.

In English, they have been writing stories from different characters viewpoints, based on a chapter of the books: 'The Boy at the Back of the Class'. While in Mathematics it has been division, division, division with Yr5 mastering division with remainders and Year 6 mastering long division! Fab-u-lous everyone!



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Phonics and Early Reading

Previously in school, we followed the comprehensive government document: Letters and Sound, to teach our phonics from the beginning of school to the end of Year 2. Since its removal, by the government, we have been researching the most comprehension programme to replace it.

After much deliberation, we have decided to purchase the scheme: Little Wandle. Little Wandle is a scheme created by teachers, for teachers and has been critiqued and developed for over 18 months. It is a thorough, progressive guide which we will implement after the Christmas holidays.

The programme, begins with 6 hours of training, which every member of staff across school is completing and is supported by excellent resources, many of which we have to thank our PTA team for. Thank you very much!

The programme is supported by books which specifically match the phonic knowledge the children already have - making the books fully decodable for the children.
