SCHOOL PARKING


There have been many complaints this week, regarding the parking outside school. As the mornings and evening are becoming lighter, many parents/ carers are choosing to walk their children to school and feel unable to do so, due to inconsiderate parking and vehicles not following the one-way system.

I have contacted the Parish Council and asked them if they are able to remark the yellow zig-zags which should cover the front of the car park - as this is a no parking zone. I completely understand that in a morning we are all in a rush, however, we all need work together to ensure our school remains safe and also disagreement free.

I have spoken to staff to ensure that the gate is supervised from 8.50am. Please be aware that children can be dropped off from 8.50 am and picked up until 3.40pm, to stagger the number of cars using the car park at these times.
